

To all participants in the Tunmore South Norfolk Pool League,

In light of the new government advice. published today, on the avoidance of gatherings within the pubs and clubs and mass gatherings as a whole, it is evident that we now need to suspend the pool season with immediate effect and until further notice.

As a committee, we feel it would be irresponsible to support the continuation of the Pool league and it's associated competitions at this time. To do so would constitute actively going against current government and medical advice.

With this in mind, all fixtures, including matches due to be played on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> March 2020, will postponed until further notice.

We would like to make it clear that, at this stage, the season is temporarily suspended and not concluded and that all current league positions and cup rounds will be maintained.

Going forward, we will act upon further guidance in relation the scheduling of any outstanding matches and the resumption of the league, as and when we are able to do so.

It is currently our intention to stick to the original finals date of Sat 13<sup>th</sup> June. However, at this stage, we are all unclear about the effect and impact that possible further restrictive measures and developments will have upon the ability to hold the finals event on this date and at the venue. We will review the ongoing situation and ensure that regular updates are circulated as and when appropriate.

As you can imagine this is a difficult decision to have to make but we feel at this stage, it is the correct one.

This is currently also a very difficult time for many people and we hope that you all remain well and support other team members and those within the community who may not be able to access local services.

We would like to thank you all for your co-operation and hope that you fully understand why this decision has been made.
